Friday, November 18th

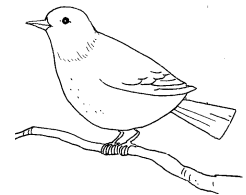

Scat Search

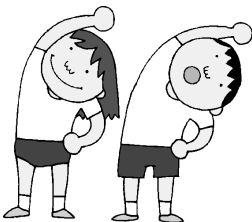
Friday, January 13th
